OVERVIEW

The Medical Response On-site Training program is a hands-on, exercise based session intended for employee, staff and occupant Emergency Response Team (ERT) members to increase experience and effectiveness in dealing with injuries or illness until professional assistance arrives.

Attendees practice use of essential elements of an Emergency Action Plan (EAP) related to emergency notification/communications, local equipment, supplies and procedures related to various medical emergencies with facilitated instructor guidance to develop basic leadership and team skills.

Customization of this presentation allows for adding details of any specific information (contacts, chain of command, maps/other documentation, etc.), requires client supplied information and prearranged access to the facility.

- Scene safety & primary patient assessment
